CHAMPAGNE - Light body style

Codorniu **Brut** Spain \$42
Dry, delicately fruity sparkling wine showing crisp citrus and white fruit flavors with a hint of toast.

CHAMPAGNE - Medium body style

Piper Heidsieck **Demi Sec** Champagne, France \$100
The higher dosage of sugar balances perfectly with the natural acidity of the wine. Made with Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier with up to 20% Chardonnay in the final assemblage and aged for at least 2-3 years before release.

Taittinger **Brut** Champagne, France \$112
Blended from a high proportion of Chardonnay grapes to yield a fine palette of pear and stone fruits offset by warm, yeasty notes and hints of bread crust.

Moet & Chandon **Brut,Imperial** Champagne, France \$110
Lively champagne. Generous, fresh champagne with hints of lime, lemon and white fruits

Piper Heidsieck **Rosé Brut** Champagne, France \$100
A lively, generous and intense wine. Its freshness is expressed by the slight tartness of red fruit, which then mellows with aromas of macerated fruit and red plums.

Gloria Ferrer **Sonoma County Brut** Sonoma, CA, USA \$65
Delicate pear and floral notes backed by toasty almond. On the palate one finds lively citrus, toast and apple flavors overlaid with persistent sparkle.

CHAMPAGNE - Full body style

Taittinger **Comtes De Champagne Rosé 1999** Champagne, France \$300
An elegant rosé predominantly from Pinot Noir grapes from Grand Cru villages of the Montagne de Reims. Red berry fruit with nuances of earth and yeast.

Piper Heidsieck **Brut** Champagne, France \$90
The first impression is lively and fresh. Citrus notes take on a distinct maturity. There is passion with gentleness, lightness with spontaneity.

Dom Pérignon **Champagne 1999** Champagne, France \$250
Dom Pérignon is the unique spirit and style of truly exceptional champagne. The 1999 vintage has impeccable balance and is supremely elegant.

Ripe and subtle, this Chardonnay shows vibrant fruit flavors with notes of melon and minerals, gently touched with oak, ending in a fresh, silky finish.

The taste is crisp and fresh and delivers full varietals flavors. The acid and the semi-sweetness are perfectly balanced for an excellent mouth feel.

Great classic, hand-crafted Riesling from a small family estate. Bright acidity and an expressive minerality

A firmly structured wine that exudes rich citrus and gooseberry fruit offset by flint, mineral and herb nuances set in a high-toned acidic balance.

This wine shows fresh, fruity, grassy aromas and multi-layered flavors of melon, fig and tropical fruit offset by a touch of oak, ending with a clean, citrus-like finish.			

Kendall-Jackson Sauvignon Blanc 2006 California, USA \$34
Lime, melon and Anjou pears intermingle with sweet and tropical fruits such as fig and kiwi to create this delightfully refreshing wine.

Duckpont Pinot Gris 2006 Oregon, USA \$48
Fruity aromas of ripe fruits; lemon and peach. On the palate fruit tones and vanilla flavors.

Bollini Pinot Grigio Reserve 2006 Friuli, Italy \$54
The intensely fragrant varietal expression of this wine shows ripe elegant pear and stone fruit flavors and aromas with notes of tree blossoms, almonds and minerals.

Veramonte Sauvignon Blanc 2007 Casablanca Valley, Chili \$34
Fruity, intense notes of peach, pineapple and hints of gooseberry. A fresh, crispy, well-balanced wine with pleasant acidity that makes it appealing and friendly.

WHITE WINE - Medium body style

Moreau Chablis 2004 Burgundy, France \$48
This Chardonnay wine has intense fresh fruit aromas and mineral hints. A crisp finish with ripe fruit characteristics.

Chateau Ste.Michelle Chardonnay 2006 Washington State, USA \$34
This Sauvignon Blanc is from one of the most prominent Horse Heaven Vineyards in Washington. A palette of natural varietal flavors of spice and melon

Maison Louis Jadot Chardonnay 2006 Burgundy, France \$52
An extremely elegant wine, pale gold, and delicately scented in bouquet. Dry but not astringent, lean yet with a slightly flinty complexity and subtle body.

Barton & Guestier Vouvray 2007 Loire, France \$36
Wine made of the Chenin Blanc grape. This Vouvray shows floral notes, peach and pear flavors and a refreshing finish.

Bollini Chardonnay 2007 Trentino, Italy \$42
This clean wine is fresh, crisp and well-balanced, with ripe melon, pear and apple flavors offset by subtle, toasty oak nuances underscored by a fine acidic note.

Cakebread Cellars Sauvignon Blanc 2005 Napa Valley, CA, USA \$76
Intense melon and citrus fruit aromas with delicate floral and herbal notes and a slight touch of oak on the vibrantly fruity palate.

Clos du Bois **Sauvignon Blanc 2006** North Coast, CA, USA \$52
This light silver/green wine has aromas of fresh melon and grapefruit with notes of toasty oak. Flavors grapefruit, fresh cut grass, elderflower and pear.

Greg Norman **Chardonnay 2007** Australia \$39
Aromas of peach and melon gain complexity with subtle oak notes. These fruit aromas develop across the creamy and smooth palate.

Lindemans **Chardonnay Reserve 2004** South Australia \$36
Bright, ripe tropical fruit flavors like melon and peach are complemented by the subtle use of French and American oak to give great depth on the finish.

Ferrari-Carano **Chardonnay 2005** Alexander Valley, USA \$76
Its lovely tropical aromas are accompanied by layers of pineapple and mango flavours, balanced with soft, toasty oak.

WHITE WINE - Full body style

Maison Louis Jadot **Puligny-Montrachet 2004** Burgundy, France \$102
This elegant Chardonnay is characterized by peachy stone fruit and melon. The wine has a firm balanced structure and a fresh finish.

Schug **Chardonnay 2007** Sonoma Coast \$54
Winemaker Walter Schug brought his traditional winemaking style to California; Schug respects the fruit and regional character of each varietal.

Kim Crawford **Sauvignon Blanc** Marlborough, New Zealand \$50
This wine has a wide range of aromas and flavors from tropical fruit and stone fruit through to herbaceousness.

Benziger **Chardonnay 2005** Carneros, CA, USA \$48
This ripe wine shows pineapple and sweet citrus flavors with vanilla and toasted oak aromas, which carry into a smooth, silky texture with notes of butter and apple.

Cabreo **'La Pietra' Tuscany 2003** Tuscany, Italy \$86
Bright pale gold in color with an elegant nose of white fruit, spice and integrated vanilla notes. This Chardonnay delivers a rich, buttery texture, and firm backbone.

Cakebread Cellars **Chardonnay 2005** Napa Valley, CA, USA \$100
This classic Napa Chardonnay shows a fragrant nose of white fruits and subtle vanilla with toasty nuances highlighting pear, pineapple and melon fruit flavors.

- Bernardus Chardonnay 2007** Monterey, USA \$60
Aromas are expressive of apple and pear with notes of crème brûlée. The palette is very rich with tropical and citrus fruit flavors and oaky toast nuances.
- Maison Louis Jadot Chassagne-Montrachet 2004** Burgundy, France \$102
This generous Chardonnay shows ripe tropical and stone fruit aromas and flavors and has a broad and lengthy finish.
- Foley Estates Chardonnay Barrel Select 2001** Santa Barbara, CA, USA \$80
Tropical fruit aromas with nuances of mango, guava, citrus, and white fruit lead into a balanced mouth, marked by toasty oak, hazelnut and caramel.
- Stag` s Leap Viognier 2006** California, USA \$68
Aromas of peach, apricot, pear and exotic fruits as well flowers and spices. Soft on the palate and an elegant finish.
- Buena Vista Carneros Chardonnay 2005** Carneros, CA, USA \$60
The combination of apple, Asian pear, citrus rind, caramel and minerals creams say Carneros from start to finish: rich, pure and forward.
- Jordan Chardonnay 2006** Napa Valley, USA \$84
Brimming with fruit flavors and elegance, a buttery toastiness from the oak. Hazelnut and citrus flavors.
- William Hill Chardonnay 2002** Napa Valley, USA \$44
A creamy and bright fruit-forward style of Chardonnay, with a varied palette of flavors bursting with fresh apples and zesty tropical citrus, along with firm acidity.
- Paul Jaboulet Condrieu 2005** Rhône, France \$90
A full bodied Viognier wine from the Rhone valley. Complex in aroma and taste; ripe fruits, flowers and spices.
- Joseph Phelps Chardonnay 2004** Carneros, CA, USA \$86
Barrel fermentation contributes to a rich, toasty oak component for this firm wine, which is refined and elegant, with floral aromas and creamy, tropical fruit flavors.
- Maison Louis Jadot Corton-Charlemagne 2003** Burgundy, France \$325
Domaine des Héritiers; a complex, firmly structured white Burgundy that balances full body and elegance in a layered palette of pears, citrus and vanilla offset by a flintiness and a suggestion of cinnamon spice in the bouquet and extended finish.

ROSÉ WINE - Light body style

La Terre **White Zinfandel 2008** California, USA \$32
A crisp wine showing lingering red fruits and nice acidity combined with sweetness. The open character of this wine pleases palates of developing wine lovers.

Fortant de France **White Merlot 2004** Pays d`Oc, France \$34
Pale pink with clean aromas and flavors of cherry, raspberry and fruit drops. This off-dry wine is plump and fresh on the palate, ending in a bright, crisp finish.

Beringer **White Zinfandel 2007** California, USA \$29
The wine has fresh red berry, citrus and melon aromas and flavors, which are rounded out with subtle hints of nutmeg and clove.

Château d'Aqueria **Tavel Rosé 2007** Rhône, France \$34
A brilliant coral wine that marries succulent fruit intensity and fresh peppery notes to a zingy core of clean, refreshing acidity and a long, dry finish.

ROSÉ WINE - Medium body style

MezzaCorona **Lagrein Rosato 2005** Trentino, Italy \$32
White wine vinification with rosé color. Fruity and delicate bouquet, showing Hints of raspberry and strawberry, ending in a dry flavour, fresh and fragrant.

Julian Chivite **Gran Feudo Rosé 2007** Navarra, Spain \$42
Bright strawberry pink in color, clean and fragrant on the nose with notes of berries and fruit, lively acidity in the mouth with floral notes.

La Poussie **Sancerre Rosé 2006** Loire, France \$72
Intense aromas of raspberry, blackberries, black cherry, and strawberries.
The maturity of the Pinot Noir gives a succulent and gorgeous fruity character.

RED WINE - Light body style

Maison Louis Jadot **Beaujolais-Villages 2006** Burgundy, France \$52
America's Favorite French wine! Charming and fresh, with ripe, subtle, fruity flavors underscored by zesty nuances of peppercorns, gentle tannins and a clean acidity.

Julian Chivite **Gran Feudo Crianza 2002** Navarra, Spain \$42
From the Tempranillo grape, this wine is bright and cherry red in color with aromas of fruit, oak, and spice, soft in the mouth with notes of burnt toast.

Schug **Pinot Noir 2007** Sonoma Coast, USA \$54
Winemaker Walter Schug brought his traditional winemaking style to California; Schug respects the fruit and regional character of each varietal.

Francis Ford Copola **Pinot Noir 2006** California, USA \$52
Cherry and strawberry fruit flavors, with sweet vanilla, and cinnamon in supporting roles. This wine has a smooth, silky texture and exquisite balance.

Kendall Jackson **Pinot Noir Reserve 2006** California, USA \$52
Zestful blackberry flavors are indicative of the small clustered blue black berries of the vine. This wine is an ensemble of a coastal Pinot Noir of California.

La Pousse **Sancerre Rouge 2005** Loire, France \$72
Lively and fruity in the mouth. Complex finish with subtle spicy and woody notes. The rich tannic character ensures the evolution of the wine.

Michele Chiarlo **Barbera d'Asti 'Le Orme' 2003/4** Piedmont, Italy \$44
Pure, ripe plum and strawberry fruit flavors underscored by a crisp acidic note. This charming, succulent wine is set in a subtle texture with sweet, soft tannins.

Maison Louis Jadot **Pinot Noir 2005** Burgundy, France \$52
A classic Burgundy Pinot Noir, with refined, aromatic nose of ripe red berries and toasty, earthy nuances. Elegant, delicately structured tannins are present.

Caposaldo **Chianti 2005** Tuscany, Italy \$32
A light bodied Chianti with fruity flavors of cherry, raspberry and a blend of species, vanilla, liquorices and coffee.

Ravenswood **Merlot 2007** California, USA \$34
Rich fruit, surrounded by elegant creaminess, supple oak flavors and tannins. This merlot is friendly, flavorful and balanced.

Jean Pierre Moueix **St.-Émilion 2005** Bordeaux, France \$56
Hailing from the French Bordeaux region of St. Émilion where the Merlot grape grows to perfection, this wine has plummy stone fruit and black berry flavors.

Maison Louis Jadot **Pommard 2005** Burgundy, France \$94
Big, fresh, vibrant red raspberry and cherry flavors followed by impressions of spice and earth mark this generous, robust Pinot Noir.

Maison Louis Jadot **Moulin-à-Vent 2005** Burgundy, France \$56
This top Cru of Beaujolais is a solidly structured, medium-bodied, this Gamay wine showing intense aromas of iris, roses, spices and ripe red fruit.

R E D W I N E - Medium body style

Château Mont-Redon **Côtes-du-Rhône 2004/5** Rhône, France \$48
Estate Bottled. Sweet, ripe crushed red berry fruit flavors and aromas are offset by bright, vibrant notes of black pepper and a suggestion of leather in this wine.

Wente Vineyards **Syrah 2006** California, USA \$34
This Syrah from the well known Wente family, has flavors of blackberry jam, vanilla, cedar and spicy black peppers.

Ravenswood **`Old Vines` Zinfandel 2006** California, USA \$48
Bright, flashy, ripe raspberry, blackberry and vanilla flavors are wrapped around a soft sweet fruit core highlighted by scents of cinnamon

Graffigna **Malbec 2007** San Juan, Argentina \$30
The Malbec grape delivers delicious aromas of ripe plum fruit and currants with a twist of spice. Beautifully round and full on the palate with subtle vanilla.

Viña Salceda **Crianza 2002** Rioja, Spain \$58
85% Tempranillo and other indigenous varieties result in a classic expression of Spain's most famous region. Dark red cherry with hints of spice and wood.

Alamos **Malbec 2008** Mendoza, Argentina \$30
Blackberry fruit with spicy black pepper notes, ripe plum and chocolate flavors.

337 **Cabernet Sauvignon 2007** California, USA \$38
A Cabernet from the lodi-vineyard. This wine has aromas of mocha and dark cherry. Flavors of spices and blackberry and a velvety finish.

- Kendall Jackson Cabernet Sauvignon Reserve 2007** California, USA \$44
Black cherry, blackberry and cassis flavors. Round tannins provide a strong backbone throughout the middle. Cedar and vanilla notes on the finish.
- Maison Louis Jadot Gevrey-Chambertin 2001** Burgundy, France \$94
Aromas and flavors of ripe black cherry typical to Gevrey-Chambertin mark this wine, which shows firm tannic structure and elegant fruit.
- Foley Estates Pinot Noir 2004/6** Santa Barbara, CA, USA \$80
Layered scents of luscious cherry, spice and cranberry are offset by classic earth notes. The flavors are lush and silky, with a refined balance of moderate tannins.
- Tenuta di Nozzole Chianti Classico Riserva 2003** Tuscany, Italy \$68
Crisp, ripe red berry and cherry fruit flavors and aromas sustained by a fresh, acidic note offset by classic Sangiovese notes of earth, mushrooms and leather.
- Julian Chivite Gran Feudo Reserva 2002** Navarra, Spain \$58
One of the greatest vintages of Spain, this wine is deep ruby red in the glass, ripe and soft on the nose with notes of oak and spice, full-bodied in the mouth.
- Cakebread Cellars Merlot 2003** Napa Valley, CA, USA \$120
A spice-blackberry fragrance with a hint of vanilla leads into a full-bodied, velvety palate with flavors of cassis and ripe berries and notes of licorice and chocolate.
- Columbia Crest Cabernet Sauvignon 2005** Washington State, USA \$32
This Cabernet Sauvignon is perfectly balanced and has a distinctive richness featuring black berry and cocoa flavors.
- Craggy Range Merlot 2003** Hawkes Bay, New Zealand \$86
This rich, ripe, well-structured wine shows full black fruit flavors set in a lush, warm texture supported by ample, fine-grained tannins offset with toasty notes.
- Benziger Syrah 2004** California, USA \$44
Raspberry, cherry, allspice and toast in this wine's nose carry into full, rich bright berry fruit in the mouth with flavor intensity ending in a soft, round finish.
- Penfold's Koonunga Hill Shiraz 2005** Australia \$34
Raspberry, cherry, allspice and toast in this wine's nose carry into full, rich bright berry fruit in the mouth with flavor intensity ending in a soft, round finish.

Sequoia Grove Cabernet Sauvignon 2003 Napa Valley, CA, USA \$86
This elegant, balanced wine is marked by fine, ripe blackberry and cassis flavors and aromas with notes of spice, cedar and discreet vanilla set in a silky texture.

St. Francis Vineyards Zinfandel 'Old Vines' 2005 Sonoma, CA, USA \$58
From vineyards all over 50 years old, this wine shows ripe cherry, raspberry and plum flavors that lead into this wine's densely fruity palate.

Louis Jadot Pommard 1er Cru, Clos de la Commaraine 2001 Burgundy, France \$146
This clean, ripe, elegant wine expresses pure, sweet black cherry and blackberry fruit offset by notes of earth, minerals and almonds in a classy, silky texture.

St. Francis Vineyards Merlot 'Behler' Reserve 2001 Sonoma Valley, CA, USA \$74
A wine with dense, concentrated black fruit flavors and aromas with impressions of spice, chocolate, mocha and nutmeg with, mouth filling texture and jammy finish.

Cakebread Cellars Cabernet Sauvignon 2004 Napa Valley, CA, USA \$138
This lush yet focused wine expresses elegant black cherry, plum and cassis fruit offset by notes of chocolate, herbs and cedar.

Greg Norman Estates Limestone Coast Shiraz 2006 Limestone Coast, Australia \$52
Lifted varietal aromas of dark plum, black cherry and spice. The rich palate shows dark berry, plum and ripe cherry flavors supported by well-integrated spicy oak.

R E D W I N E - Full body style

Château Mont-Redon Châteauneuf-du-Pape 2004 Rhône, France \$78
This wine shows robust flavors of dark cherry, crushed red berries and pepper with notes of chocolate and citrus peel on the nose, set in a ripe, tannic structure.

St. Francis Cabernet Sauvignon 2005 Sonoma Valley, Ca, USA \$54
A very intense wine. A complex bouquet of cherry pie, blackberry, cassis and anise. Flavors of ripe berries and cherries.

Clos du Val Cabernet Sauvignon 2005 Napa Valley, CA, USA \$74
This classically-structured blend displays dark black fruit aromas and a hint of toast. Flavors of cassis, coffee and blackcurrant are balanced with tannins.

Trinchero Cabernet Sauvignon 2004 Napa Valley, Ca, USA \$84
A very intense wine. A complex bouquet of cherry pie, blackberry, cassis and anise. Flavors of ripe berries and cherries.

Julian Chivite **Colección 125 Reserva 2001** Navarra, Spain \$100
A truly artesian wine, only small amounts of Colección 125 Chivite Reserva are made each year. Made from Tempranillo, Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon.

Stag's Leap **Petite Syrah 2005** California, USA \$92
The nose teems with blackberries, red currants, cut hay and burnt oranges. This wine is a mouthful of rich bitter chocolate, French vanilla, and raspberries.

Tenuta Sette Ponti **Crognolo 2003** Tuscany, Italy \$120
Refined, stylish blend of Sangiovese and Merlot combines fruit with a palate of ripe wild cherries, black fruit, leather and vanilla repeated in the aromas. Firm, elegant tannins and integrated oak end in a balanced finish.

Castello del Terriccio **Tassinaiia 1999** Tuscany, Italy \$156
Tassinaiia is where Cabernet Sauvignon and Sangiovese combine to produce this Super Tuscan. Ripe, concentrated black and red raspberry flavors.

Roda **Roda I Reserva 2001** Rioja, Spain \$160
Made of 100% Tempranillo, a wine with serious structure. Shows big, black cherry, blackberry and wild herb aromas. Dense, powerful and spicy on the palate.

Michele Chiarlo **Barbaresco 2003** Piedmont, Italy \$88
This elegantly structured wine shows pure, red berry and currant flavors and aromas with nuances of violets, spice and chocolate around a restrained acidic core.

St. Francis **Zinfandel Pagani Vineyard Res. 2002** Sonoma Valley, CA, USA \$100
A massive, chewy, fragrant wine with dense plum, raspberry and cherry fruit flavors and aromas punctuated by smoke, coffee, spice and minerals.

Silvio Nardi **Brunello di Montalcino 2000** Tuscany, Italy \$114
Deep ruby in color with purple highlights, this wine shows an intense bouquet of red berries offset by notes of leather and incense on the palate. Firm, elegant tannins.

Michele Chiarlo **Barolo 'Tortoniano' 2001** Piedmont, Italy \$98
Refined, high toned red currant and berry flavors and aromas mark this balanced, elegant wine and lead into suggestions of violets, rose petals, spice and leather.

Bernardus **Cabernet Sauvignon 2003** Carmel Valley, USA \$64
The vibrant aromas express beautifully-ripened red fruits with notes of coffee and dried spices. On the palate the flavors are intense and very long.

- Jordan Cabernet Sauvignon 2003** Alexander Valley, CA, USA \$102
On the nose very herbal, herbs like sage. On the palate ripe, smooth currants and green olives.
- Joseph Phelps Cabernet Sauvignon 2003** Napa Valley, CA, USA \$100
Layers of ripe cassis and blackberry fruit on this wine's nose and palate are underscored by impressions of spice, clove and anise, with lush, plummy fruit.
- Tenuta Sette Ponti Oreno 2003** Tuscany, Italy \$186
A Super Tuscan blend of Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. Dense aromas of cassis and black fruit are offset by notes of herbs, spice and sweet oak.
- Rossi di Medelana Lupicaia 1999** Tuscany, Italy \$210
This Super Tuscan's dense, highly extracted cassis and black cherry flavors and aromas are punctuated by distinct notes of cedar, smoke and forest.
- Silver Oak Cabernet Sauvignon 2003** Alexander Valley, USA \$138
Aromas of dill and coconut. Flavors of currant, blackberry and cherry.
A firm strong wine with tannins.
- Pine Ridge Cabernet Sauvignon 2005** Napa Valley, CA, USA \$110
A super Cabernet from Napa valley. Aromas of ripe red fruits, spices.
Flavors of coffee, anise, vanilla and red fruit.
- Craggy Range Sophia 2004** Hawkes Bay, New Zealand \$106
An Internationally-styled blend of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc and Malbec. This wine is fragrant with aromas of black plums, cassis, licorice and, spice.
- Joseph Phelps Insignia 2002** Napa Valley, CA, USA \$280
Wine Spectator's *Wine of the year in 2006!* A massive, full bodied, highly extracted wine with layers of sweet, ripe black currant fruit, its flavors lead into smoke, toast, licorice, and spice notes.

Luigi Bosca **Gewurztraminer 2005** 0.5ltr Maipu, Argentina \$34
Good body, harmonious structure and a deep gold colour. Aromas of berries, guayaba, lychee and tropical fruit. A palate of fruit, spices and floral touches.

Mer Soleil **Late Harvest Viognier 2002** 0.375ltr Monterey, CA, USA \$75
The wine has a mouth-coating, nectar-like texture and a lingering honeyed-fig finish. A wine, with a dense, velvety body and flavors that stay on the palate long.

Concha y Toro Late Harvest Sauvignon Blanc 2004 0.375ltr Maule Valley, Chile \$14
A bouquet of ripe of ripe fruits like papaya, peach and hints of honey. Soft and fruity taste, slightly sweet and palate cleansing.

Fruit flavours ranging from mango to peach to lychees, Ice wine is truly a natural wonder and extreme winemaking at its best, yielding the impressions of tropical tastes wrought from the frigid extremes of the icy Canadian winter's cape.

Barton & Guestier **Sauternes 2003** 0.375 ltr Bordeaux, France \$28
Perfectly balanced, with superb concentration, the bouquet has intense botrytis aromas with hints of dried fruit, honey and spice.
